December 2nd and 4th, 2014 SPŠ Svidník, Slovakia

We agreed on the following:

1. The dates of the mobilities:

- iii. Every week there must be at least 1-2 lesson plans published on the European Media education lab (EMEL) website.
- iv. It will be agreed in advance which lesson plans will be tested during the short- time activies meeting and which individually in every institution with the results published on eTwinning space and the project website.

4. Website EMEL:

a. SPŠ Svidnik is responsible for the content and publishing of the website (by the end of February 2015).

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- b. Slovakia and Portugal will be administrators of the website.
- c. ESCOLA SECUNDÁRIA DE CASQUILHOS, Barreiro is responsible for editing and publishing of the lesson plans. All lesson plans must be sent to the project coordinator of the Portugal school.
